

Why should my library switch to the new URL as soon as possible?

Access to Scholastic's TrueFLIX, the new e-resource provided by the Office of Commonwealth Libraries, will only be available to libraries that update to the new URL. Additionally, popular EBSCO e-resources Web News and Newswires are now available directly from the list of e-resources for those that switch to the new URL. Finally, remote access statistics (for public libraries) for some e-resources will only be available by using the new URL.


After updating links, some libraries are being asked to enter an eCard or library barcode number to access the resources.

Welcome to TrueFlixTM, the only online resource that leverages the award-winning True Books content to help students hone literacy skills, build knowledge of subject-area content, and cultivate 21st Century Skills through the inquiry process. All of the True Book titles are supported with a deep and diverse reservoir of related content and primary sources featuring videos, audio, images, and text.

Each TrueFlix™ title includes the following elements:

- Note: The Video: A streaming video that engages the student and introduces the topic. The video is strategically placed—and supported by reading research—to enable the student to build crucial background knowledge before accessing the book.
 Read the Book: A flipbook version of the True Book with page-turning and read-along features, chapter tabs, and vocabulary terms identified and defined. 

TrueFlix is an online resource that combines award-winning True Books content with reading supports and a deep and diverse collection of related videos, images, Web links, and text. TrueFlix is based on the True Books print series published by Children's Press, an imprint of Scholastic Library Publishing. TrueFlix is published by Scholastic inc., with editorial development, content management, and engineering provided by Scholastic Library Publishing.

GETTING AROUND

Home and Browse

The TrueFlix Home screen offers two browse options: a category browse and a thumbnail browse.

The category browse utilizes the two groups of TrueFlix titles on the left and right of the screen: People, Places, and History to the left and Science and Nature to the right. Below these titles are nine and twelve tabs, respectively, which correspond to each of these two groups' categories. For People, Places, and History, the categories are American Indians, Ancient Civilizations, Biographies, The Civil War, Continents, The Thirteen Colonies, U.S. Government, U.S. Regions, and Westward Expansion. For Science and Nature, the categories are Animal Kingdom, Disasters, Earth Science, Ecosystems, Experiments, Extreme Nature, Extreme Science, Health, Human Body, Outer Space, Physical Science, and The Solar System. Clicking on one of the 21 categories accesses a category browse screen from which you can choose among thumbnalls for all the TrueFlix units in that category. Clicking on any of these thumbnalls brings you directly to the title screen for that unit.


The thumbnall browse utilizes the eight large featured TrueFlix thumbnalls that rotate at the center of the Home screen and the carousel of thumbnalls that rotates at the bottom center of the screen. Clicking on any of these thumbnalls brings you directly to the title screen for that TrueFlix unit.

To return to the Home screen, click on the link at the upper-left corner of the screen.
